How it'll work

Housing association tenants and people engaged with local support services will be able to select, create and keep a 'work suitable' outfit from their local store for free.

Clothing will be accessible across four key hubs: Cardiff, Rhondda Cynon Taff, Caerphilly and Vale of Glamorgan.
